



Information about the Swedish Child Health Service Register

We collect information about children. This helps us to develop the child health service.

The information is stored in a register called the Swedish Health Service Register (abbreviated as BHVQ in Swedish). The information concerns consultations and examinations at child health service centres and is used to improve the standard of child health service. All children and parents are entitled to receive good help and support.

If you do not wish to be included in the register, speak to your nurse at the child health service centre.

All information about you is confidential and will only be used for the purpose of research and development. Only authorised individuals can see it.
